GENERAL DESCRIPTION

To assess the contestant’s ability in sewing construction related to the field of women’s fashion technology.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

- 1) Using **Simplicity pattern # 2846** for the purposes of this competition, we ask that you only use the options/modifications listed on the pattern package. Judging criteria will be based upon specific garment assembly techniques and fabric selection.
- 2) Please arrive with your pattern pinned and ready to cut on the morning of the contest.

The garment to be sewn for the competition will be knee length dress (View B) in your size.

- 3) Competitors will be judged on pattern layout. **DO NOT cut prior to the contest.** On the day of the competition, students will be required to construct their garment.

The **Garment Information Sheet** (see attached) must accompany your pattern layout on the morning of the competition.

Competitors are encouraged to sew a practice garment at home or school, in order to establish assembly techniques and timelines for completion.



Equipment and Materials supplied by Committee:

- ironing boards
- domestic irons
- domestic sergers
- Sewing machine, needles and bobbins

Equipment and Materials competitors must supply:

- Students will be required to purchase **Simplicity # 2846** and select and purchase fabric(s) and notions of their choice.
- Price of fabric is **NOT** to exceed \$15.00 per meter
- **Total of fabric choice must not exceed 1.5m x 150cm or 2.0m x 115cm.** (note change from Jan 6, 10 version)
- **Students should purchase garment notions prior to the competition** (notions include 22” Zipper, hook& eye, thread, 1 package ½’ wide single fold bias tape, 0.4m of 50cm-60 cm lightweight fusible interfacing).
- Competitors will be reimbursed \$40.00 to assist in recovering the cost of for the pattern, fabric and notions.
- Equipment and supplies needed to construct garment (e.g.: tape measure, pins, scissors, marking equipment, etc.)
- Appropriate hanger for your garment.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Competitors will be judged on the following criteria:

- Pattern Layout
- Hem Finish
- Seams
- Seam Finishes
- Zipper closure
- Design Details
- Finishing
- Fabric Choice
- Pressing

IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Competitors are expected to wear clean, appropriate attire, no open toe shoes allowed. Cell phones are not allowed in the competition area.

TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

The highest score in the “Finishing” section of the judging form will be used as a tie breaker.
