VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION

The Provincial Skills Canada Competition is only possible with the work and ideas of hundreds of volunteers. Each Skills Competition event requires expert, fair, and neutral judges to ensure a quality competition for all participants.

Judges should have education and experience in the field of the Skills Competition they are judging.

General Duties:

1. Judge the competitors following all judging guidelines and criteria outlined by the Provincial Technical Committee (PTC).
2. Provide feedback to participants, analyzing their performance.
3. Attend the event on May 12 and May 13, 2010.

Time Commitment:

1. Attend the Provincial Skills Canada Competition, held annually, in May. The 2010 competition is May 12 – May 13, 2010. Time commitment during the event may vary by competition.
